Bylaw No 2018-03

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS REGARDING A CAR, TRUCK, BUS, TENTS, MOTOR HOME, CAMPER OR TRAVEL TRAILER WITHIN THE TOWN OF NOKOMIS TOWN LIMITS.

The Council of the Town of Nokomis in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. No car, truck, bus, motor home, camper or travel trailer shall be used for permanent human habitation, whether or not the vehicle is mounted on wheels, without prior Municipal approval from Council with the exception of an approved Campground.
- 2. No tents of any kind shall be used for permanent human habitation without prior Municipal approval from council.
- 3. At no location on Municipal roads or boulevards shall it be permitted to leave an unlicensed car, truck, bus, motor home, camper or travel trailer. A boulevard shall mean a strip of ground between the edge of private property and/or sidewalk and the roadway.
- 4. At no location on Municipal roads or boulevards shall it be permitted to leave a licensed motor home, camper or travel trailer for more than 5 days without prior Municipal approval from the Administrator and/or Council.
- 5. Penalties for any infractions of this bylaw will be as follows:

- 1st offence: a warning

- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense: a \$150.00 fine

-3<sup>rd</sup> offense: car, truck, bus, motor home, travel trailer or tent removed and impounded at the owners' expense
